SPENT Internship Guidelines & Requirements

Full-Time

Each intern is required to be in attendance full-time during the prescribed days and hours for the SPENT Internship.

SPENT Internship Tuition - \$250.00 for 2009

Interns will raise support to cover Internship expenses prior to acceptance into the SPENT Internship. The Internship is a time set aside for you to fully focus upon the Beauty Realm of your God. Teaching topics, Harp & Bowl training, time spent in Intercessory Worship in The Prayer House, Outreach and other activities are all designed to continually point you to the Father and greater intimacy with Him.

Refund Policy

Personal Expenditures

Each intern must have sufficient funds to cover any personal expenses that they may incur throughout the Spent Internship. Since interns will be discouraged from seeking outside employment due to time commitments during their stay, it is advised that each intern have at least \$20 in personal spending money per week (to cover car, laundry, additional food, and any other personal expenses).

Health Insurance

Medical insurance and potential medical costs are the sole responsibility of each intern. Neither The Prayer House nor the Spent Internship program will be able to provide coverage for any hospitalization and/or any visits to the doctor, or other related medical expenses.

Vehicle

Since the scheduling and ministry assignments are so frequent and varied, we highly recommend that each intern have access to a reliable vehicle throughout the Internship. All interns who do not have a vehicle are still held responsible for their own transportation needs (i.e. punctuality to class, meeting times, etc.).

Vehicle Insurance

Liability insurance is required for every vehicle in the State of California. If you are from another state or country, it will be your responsibility to ensure that your vehicle is adequately insured during your stay in Chico, CA.

Housing & Related Expenses

The Prayer House staff has arranged for local families to provide housing for SPENT interns. Please let us know immediately if you will be arranging your own housing or would like to take advantage of staying with a Host Family for the internship. While most if not all of the Host Families will allow interns to stay for free, it is up to each intern to work out the details of this arrangement with their Host Family, including the expectations of the Host Family, potential costs, family life, etc. With the exception of the Outreach, possible housing expenses, meals and transportation are not included in the SPENT Internship tuition. Interns are responsible for meals, housing costs and other related expenses. Discuss these things with your Host Family ahead of time. We encourage you to make a budget to include provision of personal items needed (or desired) during the course of the summer: pocket money, hygiene items (shampoo, toothpaste, etc.), haircuts, recreation, and so on.

Dating

During the Spent Internship, dating is not permitted for interns. The purpose of the Internship is to give oneself to God without distractions. This time is to be used to further establish a standard of intimacy that will last a lifetime. We're confident that you will find that if you separate yourself to God, your reward will far outweigh the sacrifice.

Vacation

There will be no scheduled vacations or personal breaks during the SPENT Internship. Examples: weekend trips, family reunions, graduations, weddings, concerts, or any other personal events. This Internship is to be valued as a season of consecration to the Lord.

Fasting

Fasting is not an outdated oddity! Fasting is an assumed practice for believers, Matthew 6:6-18. Interns will be moving into fasting. Typical fasting will be a "food fast" (water or juice) unless for medical reasons. Other forms of fasting will be utilized as well.
